### ROGER LEWIS

Roger is currently serving his first year as Society President. In the past he has served at the Society level as Executive Vice President, Board Member, Chairman of Society Events Committee and served on various subcommittee and task force assignments. He has been a Battle Creek Chapter Member for 41 years and has been, Chapter President twice and has held most other chapter offices.
